Our Herd Dynamics program uses Equine Assisted Learning to create partnerships between participants, horses and coaches. This experiential opportunity is not about riding or horsemanship skills but rather collaboration through activities, observation and discussion to guide personal and professional growth.

As prey animals, horses have heightened emotional awareness and the ability to read and reflect our energy. They exist in the moment and respond authentically to our body language and intention. Working with specially trained horses creates confidence and presents analogies for dealing with challenging situations in life.



Herd Dynamics is a highly productive approach to improve effective communication, problem solving and team-building skills. With Herd Dynamics, participants experience hands-on learning and are able to apply what they practiced with horses to professional and daily life situations.

Billing:

-A deposit of 30% of the total is required in order to schedule a session. The deposit is part of the session fee, but it is non-refundable if the session is cancelled by the attending organization with less than 45 days notice. If a cancellation is made on the day of, there will be no reimbursements for the session.

-Invoices will be sent to the team lead via email. The deposit invoice is due in order to secure the session date. The remaining payment will be due 10 days prior to the session.

Day of Logistics

Clothing & footwear:

Dress for the weather, in clothes you don't mind getting dirty. Please wear sturdy shoes (tennis shoes, or boots) NO SANDALS or open toed shoes. Depending on the time of year, we may be in a heated arena or outside.

Allergies:

Dirt, hay, grass, dust and animal hair are part of being at a barn. If you have allergies, please come prepared so that you are comfortable for the duration of your workshop.

Food & water:

Water and snacks are provided. Please inquire for additional catered menu options.

Paperwork:

Online survey forms should be filled out before arriving at the barn. Liability forms will be filled out on-site.

Parking & address:

Our address is 4301 county Rd. 24, Medina/Maple Plain, MN 55359. We share our facility with the Three Rivers Park and are located on the Public Safety property. Parking is free. There is a sign by the entrance. You can park anywhere on the pavement (including down the driveway). Please do not park by the barn or in the reserved police parking.
